From an ex-pat point of view, what is life like in Barcelona?

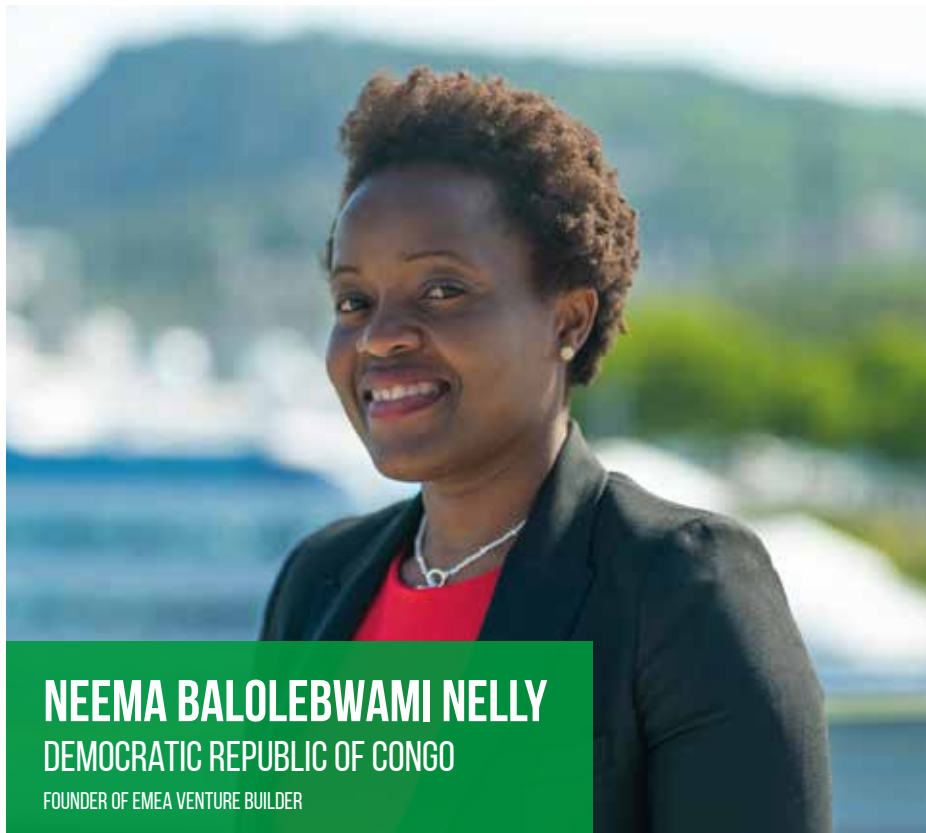
I think Barcelona is a fantastic place to live as an ex-pat. You can reach any place in Europe in two or three hours and you can always come home and enjoy a wonderful climate.

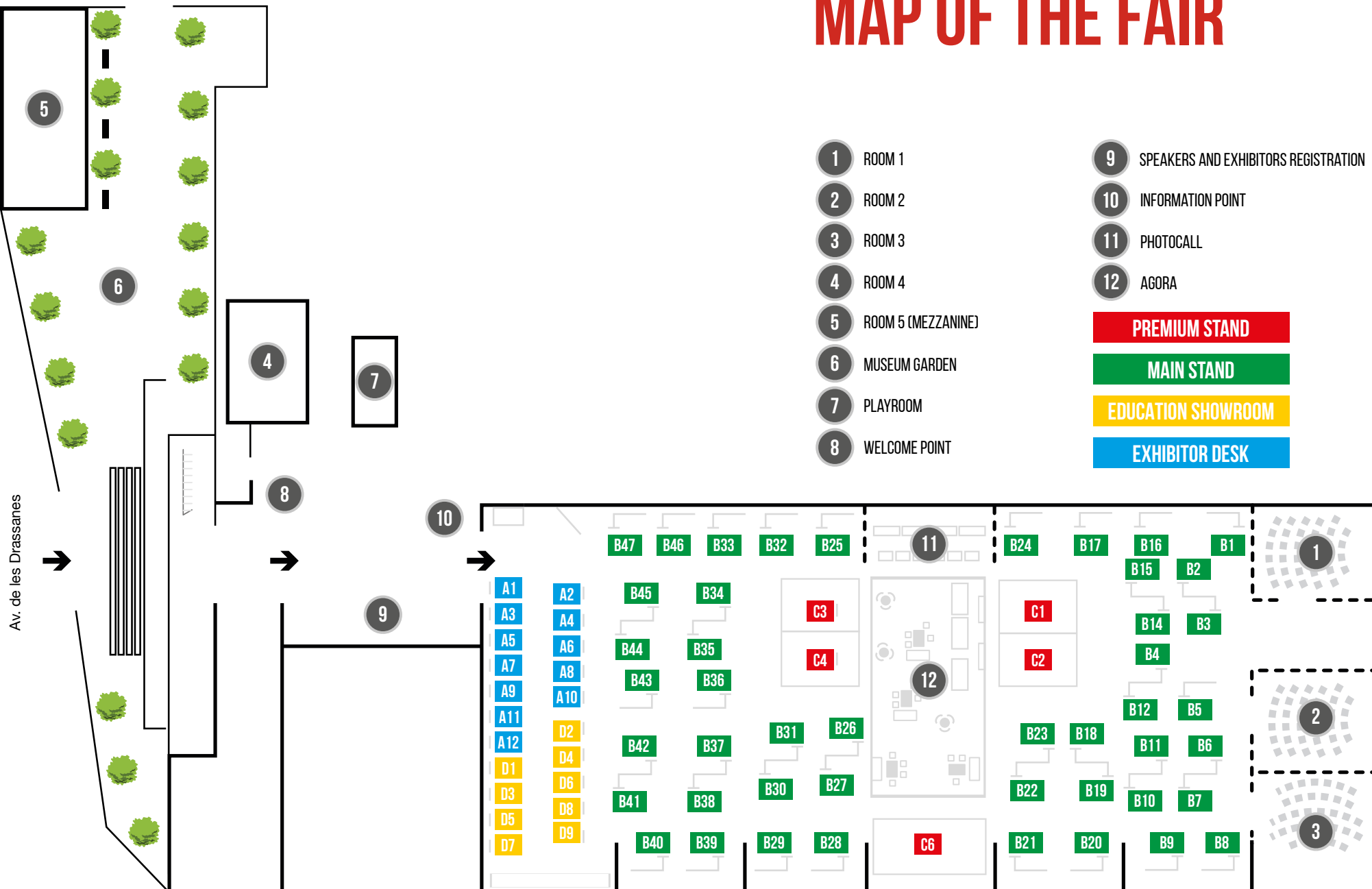

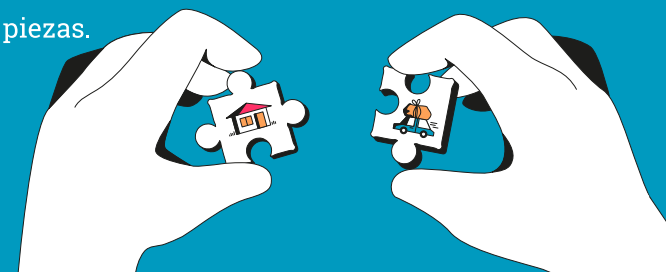

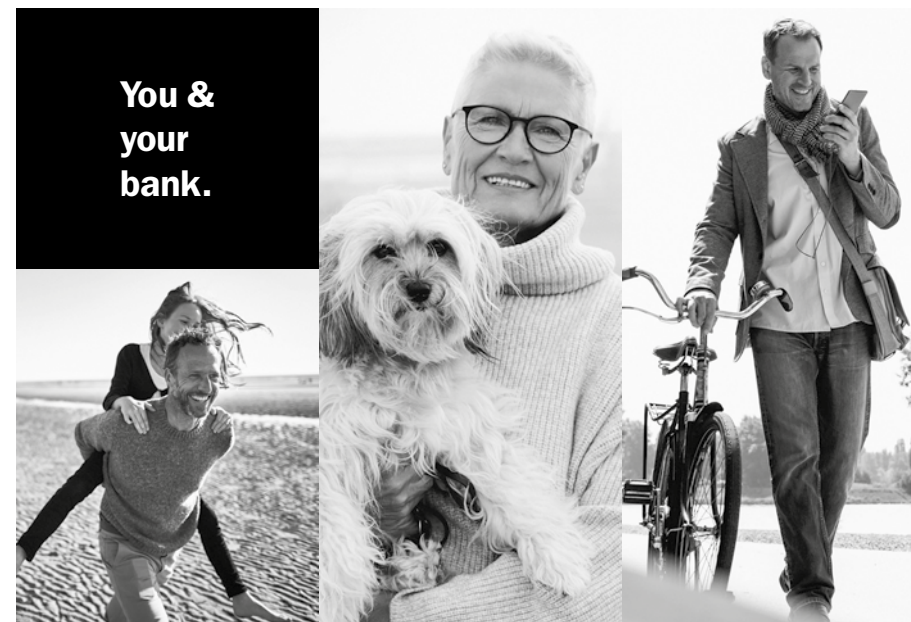
